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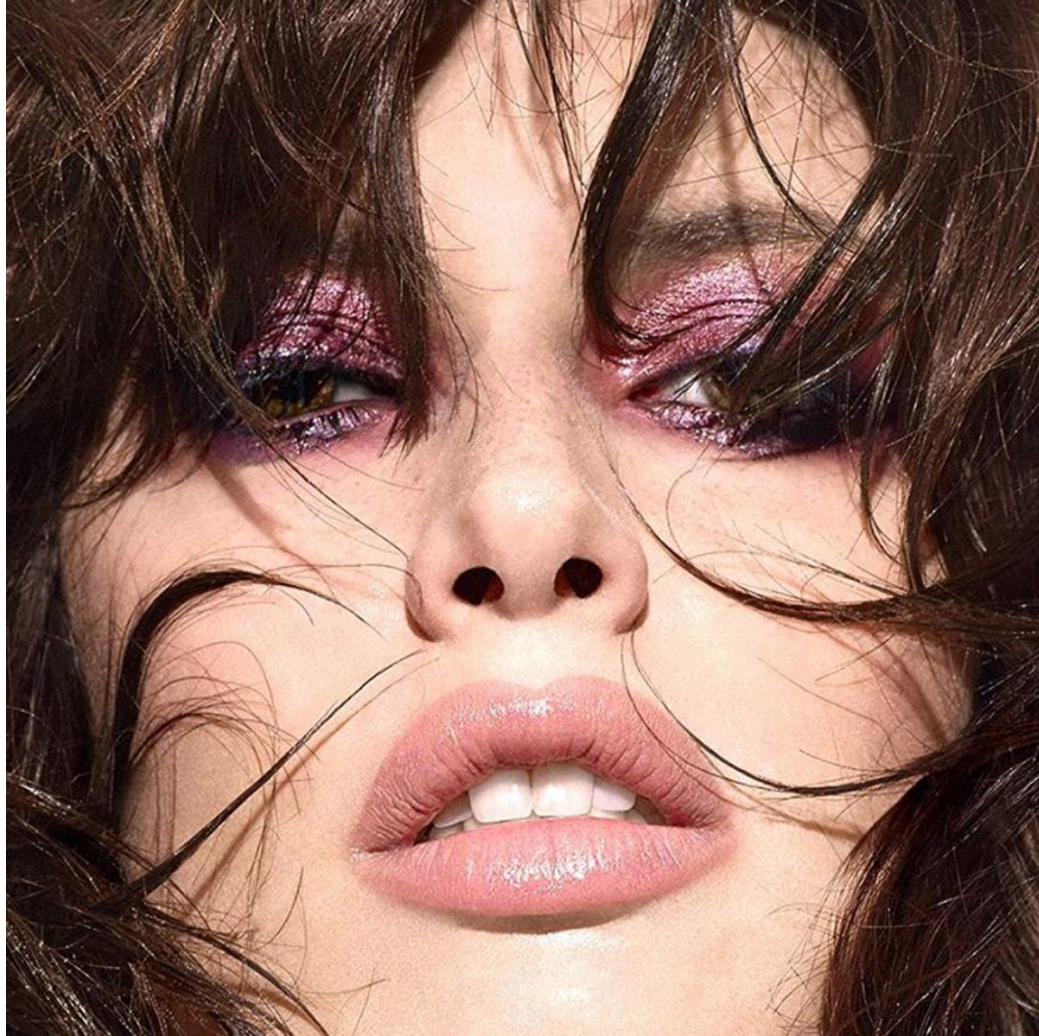

Simple color makeovers

If your shade bores you, try one of these subtle changes to help your hue feel fresh again.

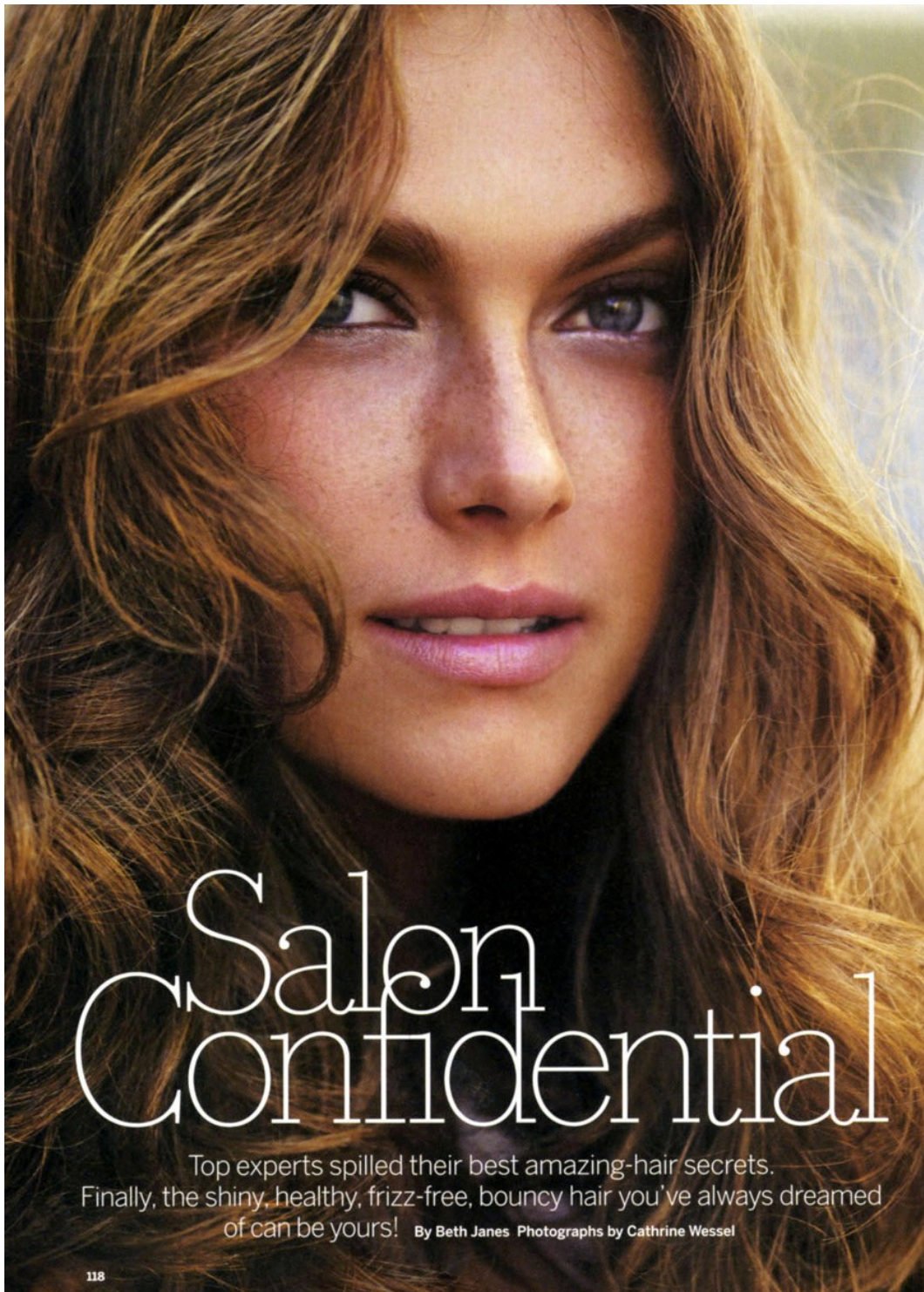
For color virgins and single-process color Don't want to make the jump to highlights? Beat the blahs with a semipermanent color rinse, which enhances shine and shade. "It's an instant pick-me-up," says Sharon Dorram-Krause, head colorist at John Frieda in NYC. "You'll look as if you've been to the beach." It washes out after four to six weeks, so there's no risk.

For highlighted hair Ask for skinny, slightly darker lowlights all over or only on the lower half of your head. Doing this warms your shade and adds depth without creating a completely different look. Find a colorist who uses foils versus balayage (painting highlights freehand). "Unless the person is an expert, you'll get more exact results with foils," Dorram-Krause says.

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
