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
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
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Wentworth Miller • Arrival

You'll be a star. Wentworth Miller heard that a lot two years ago. Then he got the opportunity to look like this and then he had a coveted role in a fall prestige pic—one based on a Phillip Roth novel, no less—opposite Nicole Kidman and Anthony Hopkins. Unfortunately, that movie was *The Human Stain*, and while we heard it was good, we can't find anybody who actually saw it. "I'm certain that it would've opened more doors for me," Miller says. Not that he had to wait too long.

In a season of nonstarters, Fox's *Prison Break* is the kind of appointment television, the kind of show you had to watch live, lest 10 million other Americans learn a twist first. Miller's character's only badiculous plot—it's about a nice guy (Miller) who gets a prison's blueprint tattooed on his body to help spring his friend from behind bars—isn't an actor who could sell that story. Executive producer Brett Ratner needed a clean-cut guy, but one who wouldn't be an easy target for the baddies. And he was having a hard time casting the guy, he says, until he remembered Wentworth Miller, an eccentric actor—a Princeton grad—he'd met with for an ill-fated big-screen *Superman* project. "Wentworth has this kindness about him—that Sean Penn's got," Ratner says. He liked the guy's thousand-yard stare (see *Prison Break's* billboard). "And he had intelligence, which is different from most good-looking young men," Ratner says. "I don't even know if Sean Penn could play that part."

Ratner might tend to the supermodel look. Miller, 33, is enjoying the attention a hit series brings. "People honk at me from their cars," he says. And although it can take four hours to get that tattooed skin off, there is an upside. "I haven't been working out in a while," Miller says. "I appreciate that it adds shading and contours where there are none."



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
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
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
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Dan KENNEDY
