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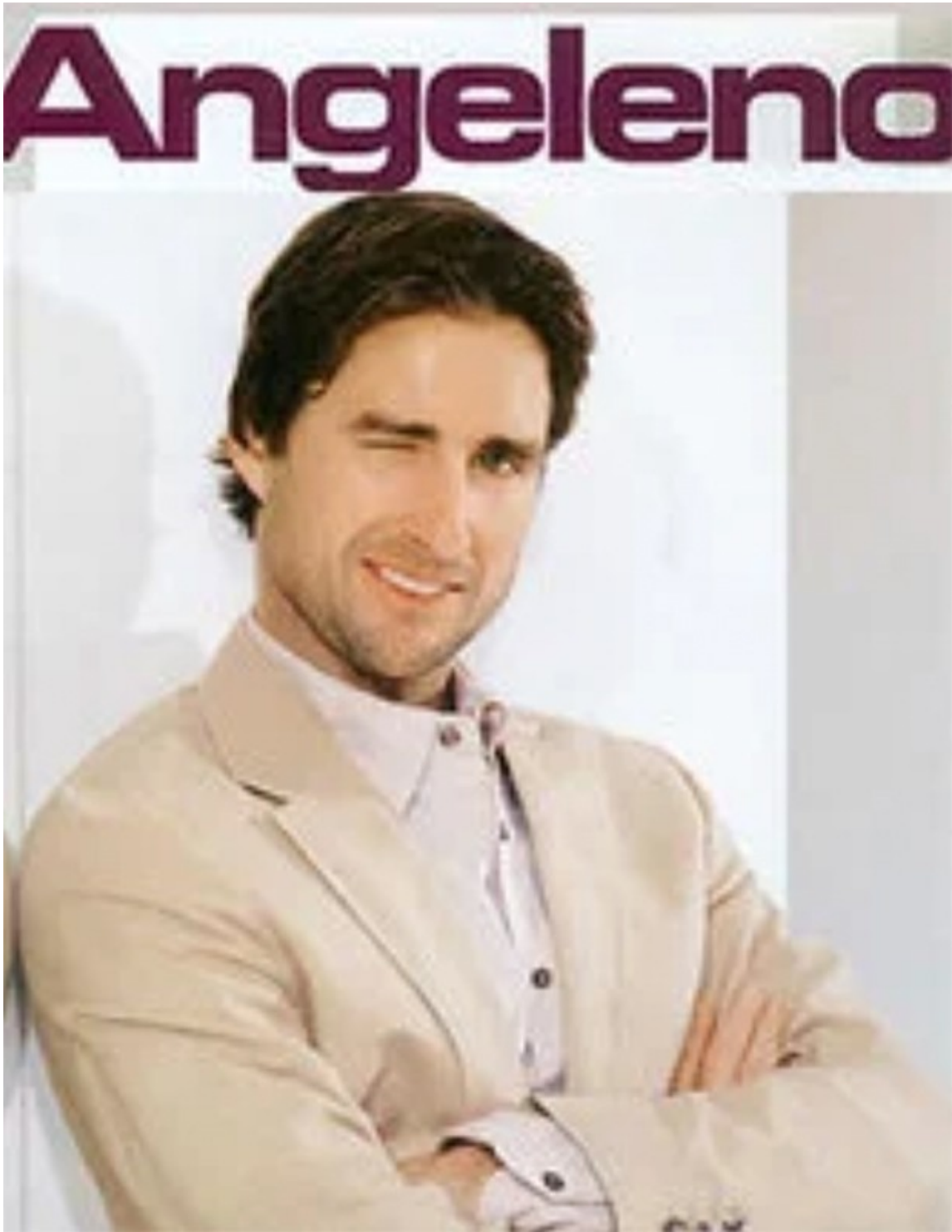
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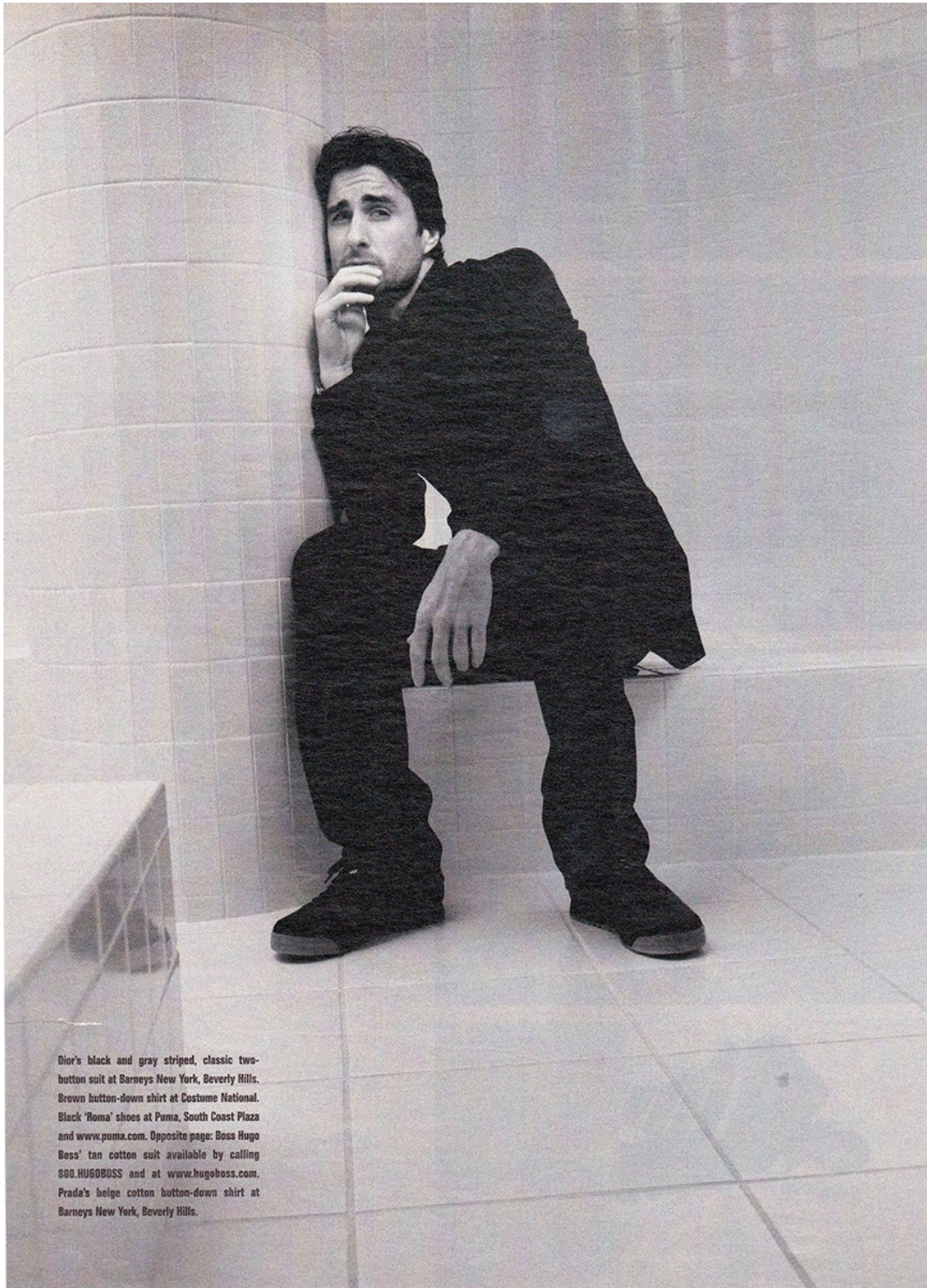
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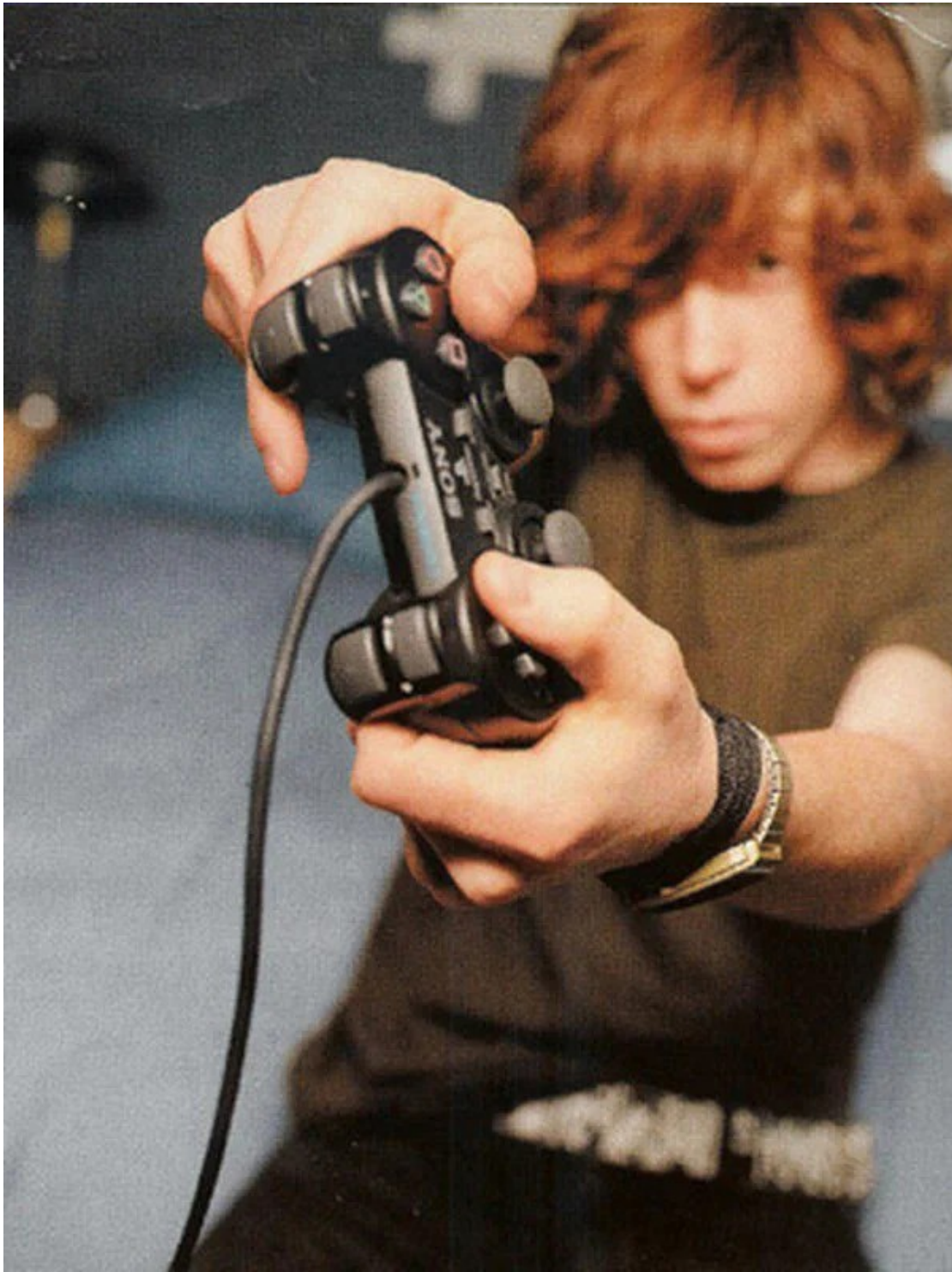

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Geoffrey Rush

"When you decide to do a role like this, morals don't come into it," says Geoffrey Rush of his performance as the Marquis de Sade—writer, dramatist, scourge of the Enlightenment, and dedicated pervert—in Philip Kaufman's *Quills*. "A real bag of roosters," and so perfect for Rush, acting's answer to a Swiss Army knife. As David Helfgott in *Shine* he proved that a man can be genetically spliced with a copy of *Finnegans Wake* and survive, while his turn as the cobra-faced Walsingham in *Elizabeth* came etched in charcoal. Rush seems capable of turning in an instant from felon to fool, and back again in time for tea. Perfect training for the marquis, in other words. "He hit out at the world and he wanted the world to hit back hard," says Rush. "That was his pleasure and his pain."
